About this role

We are seeking young people aged 14 – 19 to be part of a trained team of ten young listeners to plan and deliver our listening project to gain the views and ideas of young people in Southwest Wiltshire about the local services and opportunities that are available to them. The team will then bring these findings together and work with the S4S team; staff, trustees, and youth committee members to review and update of Theory of Change, to reflect the identified local need. This work is funded by the Blagrove Trust as part of their Restart Youth Programme and will be completed by 31st May 2022.

We are seeking young people with effective communication skills and teamwork, ideally with some experience of leadership of listening who can take an active role in all stages of this project from planning through to evaluation. Being willing to speak to other young people who you may not know is a key requirement of this role. This is an exciting opportunity to be part of a new project and to help us ensure our charity is really responding to the needs of local children and young people.
